School dinners are free for infant children under the Universal Free School Meals Programme. The charge for junior children is £2.30 per day unless your family is in receipt of free school meals.





## The School Day

Our school timetable is:

### Absence from School

On their return to school we ask that you provide an absence note in order for attendance records to be kept up to date.

Leave of absence requests will only be granted in exceptional circumstances and at the digression of the Headteacher.

## Uniform & PE Kits

### Medicines in school

Parents with children who require medicine in school for asthma and allergies must inform school about their child's condition and send the medicines into school in a container clearly marked with their child's name and full instructions for administration. School is unable to administer except in certain situations where medicines are prescribed by a doctor and parents have completed a medicine permission form. However parents/carers are welcome to come to school at the appropriate time to administer the medicine to their child themselves. You can contact school to make an appointment to discuss individual pupil's health with the Senco or school nurse.

Please be aware that it is the parents responsibility to ensure medication is replaced by the date of its expiry.
