Dear Parents/Carers,

I would like to make you aware that there has been a positive case of COVID-19 in the school. We have worked closely with the local Public Health team to risk assess, identify and inform any pupils/students and staff members who have had close contact and are required to isolate for 14 days.

We are working hard to protect our pupils/students and staff, and minimise the impact on the education of your child. The school has developed robust plans to minimise the impact of COVID-19. As the term continues, it is important that we all stay vigilant, and ensure that anybody experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 does not attend school, and gets a test for COVID-19.

If you **do not** have symptoms of COVID-19 you **do not** need to get a test.

**The symptoms of COVID-19 are:**

- new continuous cough
- fever (a temperature of 37.8°C or higher)
- loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell

If your child develops these symptoms, however mild, at any point, please stay at home for 10 days from when symptoms started.
